

Draft CANI Job Description

The Post: Access / Environment Officer

1. Main purpose of this post is to
 - a. Raise awareness of environmental sensitivity among paddlers
 - b. Improve opportunities for access to water for paddlers.

2. This person is responsible to:
 - a. CANI Chairman, committee and members

- 3 Responsible for:
 - a. Ensuring that CANI members adhere to best practice in terms of sustainable and responsible access to water.
 - b. Liaising with Government and Non Government Organisations such as CAAN to improve access to water for paddlers.

- 4 The post is elected for a period of 1 year with the option to be selected for further office.

- 5 The duties that are involved in the job are:
 - a. Promotion of "Leave No Trace" within CANI.
 - b. Liaise with CAAN over Canoe Trails and access points.
 - c. Promote paddler survey and collate data.
 - d. Act as ambassador for paddlers over any contentious issues or in the development of access.
 - e. Provide advice and information to clubs and individuals about access points
 - f. Provide information for the website / Newsletter on access issues.
 - g. Attend Council meetings (Bi-monthly)
 - h. Meet with CDO / CAAN as required.
 - i. Other relevant duties as may be reasonably requested to ensure the efficient and effective working of CANI.
