

Draft CANI Job Description

The Post: High Performance Co-ordinator (HPC)

1. Main purpose of this post is to
 - a. Oversee the development of the N. Ireland squads for competitive disciplines.
 - b. Monitor and evaluate the CANI High performance plan.

2. This person is responsible to:
 - a. CANI Chairman, committee and members
 - b. The Squad managers.

- 3 Responsible for:
 - a. The development and implementation of the CANI High Performance Plan.

- 4 The post is elected for a period of 2 years with the option to be selected for further office.

- 5 The duties that are involved in the job are:
 - a. Developing a calendar of events in conjunction with the Squad managers / teams.
 - b. Ensure that the CANI league co-ordinator takes account of various disciplines.
 - c. Providing advice and support to squads.
 - d. Liaising with Sport NI / ICU / ISC regarding individual athletes and squad development.
 - e. Ensuring that the views of the squads are represented effectively on Council.
 - f. Attending Council meetings (bi-monthly).
 - g. Other relevant duties as may be reasonably requested to ensure the efficient and effective working of CANI.
